March 11, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Today has been 1 year since we have been working through this and I want to thank each and every one of you all for your support. Since the onset of the virus we have had 104 residents and 84 staff members test positive for COVID-19. In addition, we have completed our 3 clinics for vaccination for COVID-19. We will inform you if we have any other dates scheduled.

We have applied for visitation and are waiting to hear if we are accepted. If we do get permission for visitation, we will call each responsible party and post it on our Facebook page. Meanwhile, we want to reassure you that even though Governor Abbott has lifted the mask mandate, none of our process have changed. We continue to wear mask and other PPE (personal protective equipment) as necessary.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

WEEKLY UPDATE

March 3, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 104 residents and 84 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We have not had a positive case since February 1, 2021. We continue to test employees twice a week since our county positivity rate has been above 10%. We are excited to see that rate decreasing each week. This week the rate is right at 10%. We are hoping that if it continues to drop, we will be able to decrease testing to once a week.

As most of you are aware, Governor Abbott has stated that as of March 10, 2021, Texas will no longer be under a mask mandate. I want to clearly communicate with you that it will not change any of our internal policies or protocols. In addition, we are strongly encouraging staff to be diligent about wearing their masks in public and to practice good hygiene and social distancing.

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
